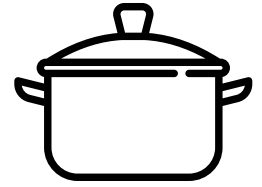

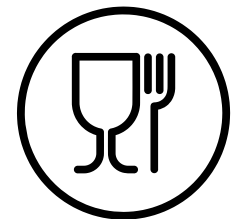
What Will I Need?

- Cooking area (Barbecue, Camping Stove, Fondue Equipment)
- Important Medications
- Cash
- Blankets, Warm Clothing
- Food / Drinks / Water
- Light Source (flashlight, candles)
- Information: Battery-run Radio (ORF V 98.2)



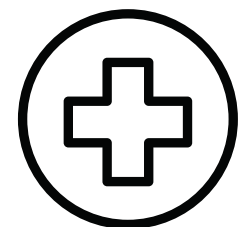
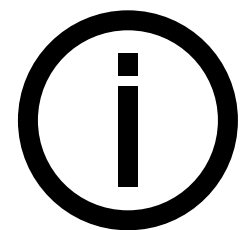
Food and Drink

- Food and drinking water for several days
- Durable food such as canned goods, instant soups
- Shops will be open the next day
- Water supply works well nearly everywhere in town



Where Can I Receive Aid?

- Emergency calls are not possible at this point. You will find help at emergency meeting and registration areas. All addresses can be found on the next page.
- In the Kulturhaus there will be a doctor on-call

- Federal Police (police station Dornbirn, Poststraße 6 nearby the Station and Foreign Police, St. Martinstraße 6)

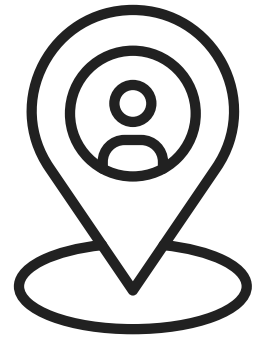

What Am I Supposed To Do?

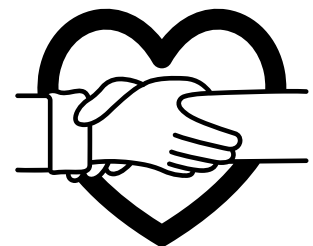
PREPARATION:

- Talk with your family: Where do we meet?
- Talk with neighbors and friends: Who needs help? Who can help?
- Think of children, elderly people, pets



IN CASE OF BLACKOUT:

- Stay calm
- Leave your car
- Stay at home
- Switch off all electric devices
- Switch on the battery run radio (ORF V98,2)
- **Pay attention to noxious poisonous gases! Use open flame (barbecue, gas cooker) outdoors ONLY!**
